



CHRIST IS RISEN!

One of the most symbolic of the Festal Icons of the Orthodox Church is that of the Holy Resurrection. In the center of this radiant event is Christ pulling Adam and Eve up from their tombs. The gates of the Realm of Death are broken and thrown down. Death. personified in human form, is defeated, and bound hand and foot at the bottom of the scene. We recall the joyous words of St. Paul: "O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?" (1 Corinthians 15:55)

Θυμόμαστε τις χαρούμενη λόγια Αποστόλου Παύλου: θάνατος, πού είναι το κεντρί σου, άδη, η νίκη σου;" (1 Κορινθίους 15:55)

GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETING

SUNDAY, APRIL 23, 2017

AFTER CHURCH

On April 16, we celebrate the feast of feasts, the Holy and Great Pascha, the Resurrection of our Lord. We have just come out of the Great 40-day fast and our celebration is at hand.

We can understand how the fasting of Lent leads into the feasting of Pascha if we hear the words of St. Gregory the Theologian, who writes, "Yesterday I was crucified with Him; today I am glorified with Him; yesterday I was buried with Him; today I rise with Him. Therefore, let us offer to Him – you may think that I am going to say gold or silver or costly stones, the mere passing material of earth possessed by slaves of the world – but let us offer ourselves, the possession most precious to God. Let us give back to the Image what is made in the Image."

We were made in the Image of the immortal God. The Fall of Adam separated us from God, while the Resurrection of Christ returns us to our original splendor.

Let us, therefore, offer to God lives that reflect this splendor and lives which are made anew in the Resurrection. Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen!

Ένα μήνυμα από Το Πατέρ Γεώργιο

Στις 16 Απριλίου, γιορτάζουμε την εορτή των εορτών, το Άγιο και Μέγα Πάσχα, την Ανάσταση του Κυρίου μας. Έχουμε μόλις βγει από την νηστεία και η γιορτή μας έφτασε. Μπορούμε να κατανοήσουμε πώς η νηστεία της Σαρακοστής οδηγεί στο γλέντι του Πάσχα, αν ακούμε τα λόγια του Αγίου Γρηγορίου του Θεολόγου, ο οποίος γράφει, "Χθες σταυρώθηκα μαζί Του, σήμερα είμαι δοξασμένος μαζί Του, χθες θάφτηκα μαζί Του, σήμερα θα ανέβω μαζί Του." Ως εκ τούτου, ας προσφέρουμε σ 'Αυτόν - μάλλον σκέφτεστε ότι θα μιλήσω για χρυσά ή για ασήμια ή δαπανηρές πέτρες, τα απλά ψήφισα πράγματα της γης που τα οποία είναι των σκλάβων του κόσμου - αλλά ας προσφέρουμε τους εαυτούς μας, το πιο πολύτιμο πράγμα για τον Θεό. Ας δώσουμε πίσω στον Θεό αυτό που έχει εμπνευστεί από τον Θεό. Η Πτώση του Αδάμ μας χώρισε από τον Θεό, ενώ η Ανάσταση του Χριστού μας επιστρέφει στο αρχικό μας μεγαλείο. Συνεπώς, ας προσφέρουμε στο Θεό μια ζωή που αντανακλά αυτό το μεγαλείο και μια ζωή που γίνεται καινούργια με την Ανάσταση. Χριστός Ανέστη! Αληθώς Ανέστη!
