Constantine became Emperor of the Roman Empire in the 312 A.D. He gave religious freedom to all Christians who had suffered untold hardships at the hands of previous Roman Emperors. Emperor Constantine built the new capital of the Empire in the ancient city of Byzantium and renamed the city Constantinople. This was the "golden age of Christianity within the Byzantine Empire. Once, before Emperor Constantine fought an important battle, he saw a cross in the sky with words surrounding it saying, "With this sign you will win." Emperor Constantine and his soldiers fought bravely and won the battle. Due to this great victory, Constantine asked his mother, Helen, to go to Jerusalem in search of the true cross of Christ. After searching for many days, Helen found a plant that smelled very sweet (basil) so they began to dig in that area and found the Cross of Jesus. When people who were ill kissed the cross, they were healed and they realized this was miraculous. Helen built many Churches in the Holy Land in particular, The Church of the Holy Cross, in the place where they found the

True Cross of Christ. Due to their tremendous contributions to the Christian Faith, Helen and Constantine have been given the titles "Isapostles" which means equal to the Apostles.



beautiful The but solemn **Epitaphio Procession on Good Friday evening was** true to our religious beliefs by faithful Parishioners mourning and encircling the grave of Jesus with prayers and songs signifying the deep sorrow of this tragic event in our Orthodox faith.

This year, the feast of the Ascension does not take place until June 6th. At that point, we will celebrate Jesus' return to the Father.
