#### The Feast of Holy Pentecost - H Πεντηκοστη



The Feast of Holy Pentecost is celebrated each year on the fiftieth day after the Great and Holy Feast of Pascha (Easter) and ten days after the Feast of the Ascension of Christ. The Feast is always celebrated on a Sunday.

The Feast commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on the day of Pentecost, a feast of the Jewish tradition. It also celebrates the establishment of the Church through the preaching of the Apostles and the baptism of the thousands who on that day believed in the Gospel message of salvation through Jesus Christ. The story of Pentecost is found in the book of The Acts of the Apostles. This miraculous event occurred on the Jewish Feast of Pentecost, celebrated by the Jews on the fiftieth day after the Passover as the culmination of the Feast of Weeks (Exodus 34:22; Deuteronomy 16:10).

When the people in Jerusalem heard the sound, they came together and heard their own languages being spoken by the Apostles (Acts 2:5-6). The people were amazed, knowing that some of those speaking were Galileans, and not men who would normally speak many different languages. They wondered what this meant, and some even though the Apostles were drunk (Acts 2:7-13). Peter,

hearing these remarks, stood up and addressed the crowd. He spoke about Jesus Christ and His death and glorious Resurrection. Great conviction fell upon the people, and they asked the Apostles, "What shall we do?" Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2:38-39). The Bible records that on that day about three thousand were baptized.

Πεντηκοστη ονομαζεται κατα την Καινη Διαθηκη η επιφοιτηση του Αγιου Πνευματος στους Αποστολους που συνεβη την πεντηκοστη ημερα μετα την Ανασταση του Ιησου Χριστου (Πραξεις β' 1-41). Σε αναμνηση του γεγονοτος αυτου, καθε χρονο, οι Χριστιανοι εορταζουν με ιδιαιτερη λαμπροτητα την εορτη της Πεντηκοστης και αυτο διοτι θεολογικα η ημερα αυτη θεωρειται η γεννεθλια ημερα της Εκκλησιας.

Την ημέρα της Πεντηκόστης ελάβε χωρά η επιφοίτηση του Αγίου Πνευμάτος στους 12 μάθητες όποτε, συμφωνά με τις Πράξεις των Αποστολών, ελάβαν το Αγίο Πνευμά μιλωντάς στις ξένες γλώσσες «για τα θαυμάστα έργα του Θεού», γεγονός που έγινε αντίληπτο από Ιουδαίους και προσηλύτους που ήταν στην Ιερουσάλημ για τη γιορτή των Εβδομάδων. Επείτα και από το κηρυγμά του Πετρού, βαφτίστηκαν έκεινη την ημέρα 3.000 νέα μέλη της χριστιανίκης έκκλησιας. (Πράξεις  $1:13-15\cdot 2:1-41$ ) Εκείνη η ημέρα ηταν 50 ημέρες μετά την Αναστάση του Ιησού Χριστού.



# Η Αγια Μεγαλομαρτυς Κυριακη - 7 Ιουλιου



Στις 7 Ιουλιου, η Εκκλησια εορταζει και τιμα την ιερη μνημη της Αγιας Μεγαλομαρτυρος Κυριακης. Ηταν μοναδικο παιδι του Δωροθεου και της Ευσεβιας. Οι γονεις της ηταν ευσεβεις χριστιανοι αλλα χωρις απογονους. Προσευχοντουσαν στον Θεο να τους χαρισει ενα παιδι. Ο Θεος ακουσε την προσευχη των ευσεβων γονεων, και μια Κυριακη γεννηθηκε ενα ωραιο κοριτσακι και της δοθηκε το ονομα Κυριακη. Απο την παιδικη της ηλικια, η Αγια Κυριακη ηταν αφιερωμενη στο Θεο.

Στο διωγμο που κηρυξε ο Διοκλητιανός εναντίον των χριστιανών, η Αγία Κυριακή ήταν περίπου είκοσι ετών. Οι γονείς της και η θυγατέρα κατηγορήθηκαν και πιαστήκαν ως χριστιανοί. Η Αγία Κυριακή χωριστήκε από τους γονείς της και την Αγία Κυριακή την οδηγήσαν στη Νικομήδεια. Εκεί ο ηγεονάς, ανακρινοντάς την Αγία Κυριακή και βλεποντάς τη σταθέρη της πίστη, εδώκε διατάγη να τη μαστιγώσουν σκληρά. Η Αγία Κυριακή σε καθέ έρωτηση απάντουσε - «Είμαι χριστιανή». Και σε

καθε απείλη του ηγεμονα ελεγε «Μην πλανιεσαι και μη σε ξεγελαει ο λογισμος σου, με βοηθαει ο Θεος και δεν θα με νικησεις». Υστερα απο εξαντλητική ανακριση, οδηγησαν την Αγια Κυριακή στο ναο, για να θυσιασει στα είδωλα. Εκείνη, μπαινοντας στο ναο, παρακαλουσε μεσα της το Χριστο να τη βοηθησει. Ενας σεισμος κατατρομαξε τους δημιους και τα αγαλματα του ναου επεσαν και εγιναν κομματια. Αναψαν υστερα φωτια για να την καψουν ζωντανή, μα οπως τη βατο του Μωυσή, την κυκλωσαν οι φλογες, μα δεν την εκαψαν. Την ερρίξαν υστερα στα θηρία, μα κι εκείνα δεν την πειραξαν. Θα περίμενε κανένας ο ηγεμονάς να ανοίξει τα ματία του και να δει το θαυμα του Θεού, μα εξάλλος και τυφλωμένος από οργη εδωκε διατάγη να αποκεφαλίσουν το αθώο κι αγνό κορίτσι.

Η Αγια Κυριακη, πριν ο δημιος εκτελεσει τη διαταγη, ζητησε να την αφησουνε να προσευχηθει. Γονατισε και αρχισε να προσευχεται. Η Αγια Κυριακη προσευχηθηκε για ωρα πολλη και υστερα εγειρε στη γη. Οταν ο δημιος πλησιασε για να εκτελεσει τη διαταγη, ειδε πως η Αγια Κυριακη ηταν νεκρη. Η ψυχη της πεταξε σαν μικρο πουλι, και ο φωτεινος αγγελος την πηρε, για να τη φερει στο Νυμφιο Χριστο.



#### Αγια Παρασκευη - 26 Ιουλιου



Η Αγια Παρασκευή γεννήθηκε στη Ρωμή το 117 μ.Χ. Οι γονείς της ήταν Ελληνές και Χριστιανοί. Ο πατέρας της ήταν ο Αγάθων και η μητέρα της η Πολιτεία. Η Αγία Παρασκευή γεννήθηκε ημέρα Παρασκευή και έτσι οι γονείς της δωσάνε το ονομά της ημέρας που γεννήθηκε. Οι γονείς της την μεγάλωσαν συμφώνα με την Χριστιανική πίστη και την σπουδάσαν αφού είχαν οικονομική δυνατότητα.

Οι γονεις της Αγιας Παρασκευης πεθαναν όταν ηταν 20 ετων. Τότε η Αγια Παρασκευή εδωσε την περιουσία της στους φτωχούς, στην εκκλησία και σε ενα ίδρυμα, στο οποίο εμέναν χριστίανες κοπέλες που είχαν αφιέρωθει στον Ιησού Χρίστο.

Καποια στιγμη εγκατελειψε το ιδρυμα αυτο και ξεκινησε να κηρυττει τον Χριστιανισμο σε διαφορες πολεις και χωρια της Ιταλιας. Γρηγορα ομως εφτασαν στα αυτια του Αυτοκρατορα Αντωνινου οι δραστηριοτητες της Αγιας Παρασκευης. Με εντολη του Αντωνινου, συνελαβαν την Αγια Παρασκευη και την οδηγησαν μπροστα του. Θελοντας αυτος να την κανει να απαρνηθει την χριστιανικη πιστη, την υποβαλει στο μαρτυριο της πυρακτωμενης περικεφαλαιας απο το οποιο, με τη χαρη του Ιησου Χριστου, η Αγια Παρασκευη βγηκε σωα.

Το τελευταιο βασανιστηριο στο οποιο υποβληθηκε η Αγια Παρασκευη ηταν ενα καζανι στο οποιο εβραζε πισσα και λαδι. Εκει εβαλαν την Αγια Παρασκευη, η οποια ομως, με την βοηθεια του Θεου, δεν επαθε τιποτα. Βλεποντας αυτο, ο Αντωνινος, την προετεψε να ριξει πανω του πισσα για να διαπιστωσει ο ιδιος αν καΐει. Η πισσα αυτη τυφλωσε τον αυτοκρατορα, ο οποιος πιστεψε τοτε στην αληθινη θρησκεια και ζητησε απο την Αγια Παρασκευη να βαφτιστει χριστιανος. Εκεινη οχι μονο τον βαφτισε, αλλα και τον θεραπευσε, με την χαρη του Θεου, τα ματια του. Η χαρη να θεραπευσει τα ματια, δοθηκε απο τον Θεο στην Αγια Παρασκευη και για αυτο τα περισσοτερα θαυματα τα της εχουν σχεση με τα ματια.



#### Αγιος Παντελεημων - 27 Ιουλιου



Ο Αγιος Παντελεημων γεννηθηκε στην Νικομηδεια, στα τελη του 3°0 αιωνα μ.Χ. Ο πατερας του ηταν ο Ευστοργιος και η μητερα του η Ευβουλη. Ο πατερας του ηταν ειδωδολαλατρης ενω η μητερα του ηταν Χριστιανη. Ο Αγιος Παντελεημων εμεινε ορφανος απο μητερα σε νεαρη ηλικια. Αφου εμαθε τα πρωτα γραμματα, διδαχτηκε τα Ελληνικα και κατοπιν ο πατερας του τον εστειλε να μαθητευσει κοντα στον γνωστο γιατρο Ευφροσυνο την επιστιμη της ιατρικης.

Μια μερα είδε στο δρομο που περπατούσε ενα φίδι να δαγκώνει ενα παίδι και αμέσως το παίδι επέσε νέκρο. Ο Αγίος Παντελέημων τότε σκέφτηκε ότι εαν ο Χρίστος ανασταίνε το παίδι και πεθαίνε το φίδι, θα γινόταν ο ίδιος Χρίστιανος. Και έτσι εγίνε. Μπροστά στα ματία του, το παίδι αναστήθηκε και το φίδι εξαφανίστηκε. Ο Αγίος Παντελέημων καταλάβε τότε ποια είναι η αληθίνη πίστη και έτρεξε στο Αγίο Ερμόλαο να του αναφέρει τι εγίνε και να του ζήτησει να τον βαφτίσει Χρίστιανο. Ο Αγίος Ερμόλαος τον βαφτίσε και του δίδαξε τα μυστήρια της Χρίστιανικής πίστης.


Ο Αγιος Παντελεημων, με την βοηθεια του Ιησου Χριστου και την προσευχη, αρχισε να γιατρευει τους συμπολιτες. Οταν ο πατερας του πεθανε, ο Αγιος Παντελεημων μοιρασε την περιουσια του στους φτωχους και συνεχισε να θεραπευει τους αρρωστους με τη βοηθεια της προσευχης. Η δραση του αυτη εκανε τους υπολοιπους γιατρους της περιοχης να τον μισησουν και να τον κατηγορησουν στον Μαξιμιανο, που ηταν ο βασιλειας. Ο Μαξιμιανος, ειδωλολατρης ο ίδιος, καλέσε τον Αγιο Παντελεημων να παρουσιαστει μπροστα του με σκοπο να του αλλαξει την πιστη.

Αφου δεν τον καταφέρε με τα λογια, τον υπέβαλε σε σκληρα μαρτυρια. Ο Αγιος Παντέλεημων με συνέχη προσευχη, οχί μονο υπέμεινε το μαρτυρια αυτά, αλλά στο τέλος καθέ μαρτυριού ήταν σωός και αβλάβης. Τέλικα ο Μαξιμιανός θανάτωσε τον Αγιο Ερμόλαο, θεωρώντας τον υπέυθυνο για την πίστη του Αγιού Παντέλεημων και διετάξε του αποκεφάλισμο του Αγιού. Κατά την διάρκεια τον αποκεφάλισμου ένα ακομή θαυμά συνέβη. Το ξίφος με το οποίο θα αποκεφάλιζαν τον Αγιο Παντέλεημων, λυγίσε σαν κέρι.

Οι στρατιωτες πιστεψαν στην χαρη του Ιησου Χριστου και αρνηθηκαν να θανατωσουν τον Αγιο Παντελεημων. Ο Αγιος προσευχηθηκε και τοτε μια φωνη ακουστηκε απο τον ουρανο, που ελεγε οτι δεν θα ονομαζεται Παντελεοντας αλλα Παντελεημων. Μετα απο το θαυμα αυτο και με παρασκληση του ιδιου Αγιου, εγινε η εκτελεση του. Ο Αγιος παραδωσε το πνευμα του ενω οι στρατιωτες εγιναν Χριστιανοι και αρχισαν να διακηρυτουν τον λογο του Ιησου Χριστου.



# The Dormition of our Most Holy Lady the Theotokos and Ever Virgin Mary - August 15 Κοιμησης της Θεοτοκου – 15 Αυγουστου



When the time drew night that our Savior was well-pleased to take His Mother to Himself, He declared unto her through an Angel that three days hence, He would translate her from this temporal life to eternity and bliss. On hearing this, she went up with haste to the Mount of Olives, where she prayed continuously. Giving thanks to God, she returned to her house and prepared whatever was necessary for her burial. While these things were taking place, clouds caught up the Apostles from the ends of the earth, and brought them, at once, to the house of the Mother of God. She blessed the Apostles, and reclining upon her bed with seemliness, gave up her all-holy spirit into the hands of her Son and God. The Apostles took up that God-receiving body and brought it to the sepulchre, while the Angels from Heaven chanted with them, and sent forth her who is higher than the Cherubim. When they had reached the place called Gethsemane, they buried her there with honor, the all-immaculate body of the Theotokos, which was the source of Life. But on the third day after the burial, when they were eating

together, and raised up the artos (bread) in Jesus' Name, as was their custom, the Theotokos appeared in the air, saying "Rejoice" to them. From this they learned concerning the bodily translation of the Theotokos into the Heavens.







#### Dear Parishioners of Saint Demetrios,

And, we are dedicated to our parish because it feeds us all the spiritual food that nourishes our souls. Let us return to our regular worship life with a renewed sense of commitment and piety, having seen what life is like without regular worship and fellowship.

Please also be certain that the Parish Council and I are speaking regularly about how to make the Church as safe as possible for all who worship at Saint Demetrios. We want to be ready to reopen as quickly as we are permitted. When we finally do meet again, we will all have to follow certain rules that may seem unpleasant or uncomfortable, but these restrictions will permit us to meet, so we must follow them. And, if we do adhere to the rules, we will once again, praise the one true God in the city of Perth Amboy. You are a faithful community of faithful people, and you deserve for your Church to be open. I hope that day will come soon. Until then, God be with you all.
