Stavros Tsapatsaris, 79 years old, passed away on Saturday, May 15, 2021 at Community Medical Center in Toms River. He is predeceased by his parents Father Nickolas and Presbytera Maria, and his brother Taki Tsapatsaris. Surviving are his wife Virginia; sons Nickolas and wife Ana and Constantino and his fiancée Tamar; brothers Vasili, Leonidas, Dimitri, and Gregory Tsapatsaris; sister Vasiliki; 2 grandchildren Mariam and Michael. He was loved by many nieces and nephews here in the United States and also in Greece. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Stavros was born in Karea, Greece, the son of a priest. He was educated in Greece and graduated as an engineer. He also trained as a Psalti. He entered the United States and was employed by the government during the Vietnam War. As a little boy, he began to assist his father who serviced four churches. Stavros remembers, at the age of five, helping his father on Holy Fridays Services four times in one day. Stavros went into the restaurant business until he suffered heart attacks and continued with heart failure that, eventually, led to a heart transplant. He prayed continuously and with profound humility, prayed to Panagia. He feels Panagia heard his prayers and carried him through a miraculous recovery. He served as a faithful Psalti in several New Jersey Churches.

We, here at Saint Demetrios Church, were enormously blessed to have had Stavros chant for us Sunday after Sunday for 13 years. His chanting was always melodious and filled with a sense of deep, limitless faith.

Κυριακη των Βαϊων Palm Sunday

Την ημεφα αυτη γιοφταζουμε την πανηγυφικη εισοδο του Κυφιου Ιησου Χφιστου στην Ιεφουσαλημ. Τοτε, εφχομενος ο Ιησους απο τη Βηθανια στα Ιεφοσολυμα, εστειλε δυο απο τους Μαθητες του και του εφεφαν ενα γαϊδουφακι. Καθισε πανω του για να μπει στην πολη.

Ο δε λαος, ακουγοντας ότι ο Ιησους ερχεται, πηραν αμέσως στα χέρια τους βαγια από φοινικές και βγηκαν να τον υποδεχτουν. «Αλλοί μεν με τα ρουχα τους, αλλοί δε κοβοντας κλαδια από τα δέντρα, έστρωναν το δρόμο απ' όπου ο Ιησους θα περνουσε.» Ολοί μαζι, ακομα και τα μικρα παιδια, φωναζαν: «Ωσαννα ευλογημένος ο ερχομένος έν ονοματί Κυρίου, ο βασιλέυς του Ισραηλ».

Ο Χριστος εισερχεται στα Ιεροσολυμα «επι πωλον ονου». Πορευεται και οι Ισραηλιτες τον υποδεχονται με τιμες ως Βασιλια. Εκεινος δεν δινει ιδιαιτερη σημασια στις τιμες, δεν περιοριζεται στο πανηγυρι, στην προσκαιρη δοξα, αλλα προχωρει στο σταυρο και την Ανασταση.

Η εισοδος του Χριστου στα Ιεροσολυμα ειναι η εισοδος του μαρτυριου στην επιγεια ζωη του Κυριου. Σε λιγες ημερες θα μαρτυρησει και θα θανατωθει στο σταυρο, για να θανατωσει το θανατο και να χαρισει τη ζωη.



On Sunday, five days before the Passover of the Law, the Lord came from Bethany to Jerusalem. Sending two of His disciples to bring Him a foal of an δονκευ, He sat thereon and entered into the city. When the multitude there heard that Jesus was coming, they straightway took up the branches of palm trees in their hands, and went forth to meet Him. Others spread their garments on the ground, and yet others cut branches from the trees and strewed them in the way that Jesus was to pass; and all of them together, especially the children, went before and after Him, crying out: "Hosanna: Blessed is He that cometh in the Name of the Lord, the King of Israel" (John 12:13). This is the radiant and glorious festival of our Lord's entry into Jerusalem that we celebrate today.

The branches of the palm trees symbolize Christ's victory over the devil and death. The word Hosanna means "Save, I pray," or "Save, now." The foal of a donkey, and Jesus' sitting thereon, and the fact that this animal was untamed and considered unclean according to the Law, signified the former uncleanness and wildness of the nations, and their subjection hereafter to the holy Law of the Gospelu






His Grace Bishop Apostolos Visit 5/16/2021


Parish Council







Happy Father's Day


Rachel Gíannakopoulos

The Altar Servers of Saint Demetrios


