

#### 2 Φεβρουαριου - Η Υπαπαντη του Κυριου

#### February 2 - The Presentation of Our Lord and Savior in the Temple



Τὸ γεγονὸς τῆς Ὑπαπαντῆς, ποὺ ἐξιστορεῖ ὁ Εὐαγγελιστὴς Λουκᾶς στὸ β' κεφάλαιο τὸ Εὐαγγελίου του, συνέβη σαράντα ἡμέρες μετὰ την γέννηση τοῦ Ἰησοῦ. Σύμφωνα μὲ τὸν Μωσαϊκὸ Νόμο, ἂν τὸ πρῶτο παιδὶ τῆς οἰκογένειας ἦταν ἀγόρι, ἀφιερωνόταν στὸν Θεὸ καὶ συγγρόνως προσφερόταν γιὰ θυσία ἕνας ἀμνὸς ἢ ἕνα ζευγάρι τρυγόνια ἢ δυὸ μικρὰ περιστέρια. Τὸ γράμμα τῶν ἐντολῶν αὐτῶν πληροῦντες ὁ Ἰωσὴφ καὶ ἡ Παρθένος Μαρία, ἀνῆλθαν τὴν τεσσαρακοστή ήμέρα ἀπὸ τῆς γεννήσεως τοῦ Χριστοῦ στὸ ναὸ τῶν Ίεροσολύμων, γιὰ νὰ προσφέρουν τὸν Ἰησοῦ στὸν Θεὸ καὶ νὰ δώσουν την θυσία περὶ καθαρισμοῦ. Τὸ ζευγάρι ὑποδέχθηκε στὸ ναὸ ὁ ὑπερήλικας Προφήτης Συμεών, ὁ ὁποῖος δέχθηκε τὸν Ἰησοῦ στὴν ἀγκαλιά του φωτισμένος ἀπὸ τὸ Ἅγιο Πνεῦμα, ἔγοντας λάβει ἀποκάλυψη ἀπὸ Αὐτὸ ὅτι δὲν θὰ ἀπέθνησκε πρωτοῦ δεῖ Ἐκεῖνον, τὸν ὁποῖο ὁ Κύριος καὶ Θεὸς ἔχρισε Βασιλέα καὶ Σωτῆρα τοῦ κόσμου. Ή έορτὴ εἰσήχθηκε πρῶτα στὴν Δύση πρὸς κατάργηση τῶν τελουμένων είδωλολατρικών έορτών, κατά τὶς ἀργὲς τοῦ Φεβρουαρίου, πρὸς τιμὴν τοῦ Πανός, ὡς καθαρῶς θεομητορικὴ έορτή. Άργότερα καθιερώθηκε καὶ στὴν Άνατολή. Κατὰ μὲν τὸν Γεώργιο Κεδρηνὸ ή έορτη εἰσήχθηκε ἐπὶ τοῦ αὐτοκράτορα Ίουστινιανοῦ τοῦ Α' (518 – 527 μ.Χ.), κατὰ δὲ τὸ Νικηφόρο Κάλλιστο ὁ μέγας Ἰουστινιανὸς (525 – 565 μ.Χ.) διέταξε, τὸ 542 μ.Χ., νὰ ἑορτάζεται ἡ Ὑπαπαντὴ τοῦ Σωτῆρος σὲ ὅλη τὴ γῆ. Ἐπειδὴ όμως διασώζονται σήμερα λόγοι - όμιλίες στην έορτη της Ύπαπαντῆς, ποὺ χρονολογοῦνται πολὺ πρὶν ἀπὸ τὸν 6ο αἰῶνα μ.Χ., εἰκάζεται ὅτι ὁ αὐτοκράτορας Ἰουστίνος εἰσήγαγε τὴν ἑορτή στὴν Ύπαπαντῆς, Κωνσταντινούπολη. Ή έορτὴ τῆς Κωνσταντινούπολη, ἐτελεῖτο στὸ ναὸ τῶν Βλαχερνῶν, ὅπου παρευρίσκονταν καὶ οἱ βασιλεῖς.

When the most pure Mother and Ever-Virgin Mary's forty days of purification had been fulfilled, she took her first-born Son to Jerusalem on this, the fortieth day after His birth, that she might present Him in the temple according to the Law of Moses, which teaches that every first-born male child be dedicated to God, and also that she might offer the sacrifice of a pair of turtle-doves or two young pigeons, as required by the Law (Luke 2:22-24; Exod. 13:2; Lev. 12:6-8). On this same day, a just and devout man, the greatly aged Symeon, was also present in the temple, being guided by the Holy Spirit. For a long time, this man had been awaiting the salvation of God, and he had been informed by divine revelation that he would not die until he beheld the Lord's Christ. Thus, when he beheld Him at that time and took Him up into his aged arms, he gave glory to God, singing: "Now lettest Thou Thy servant depart in peace, O Master. . . ." And he confessed that he would close his eyes joyfully, since he had seen the Light of revelation for the nations and the Glory of Israel (Luke 2:25-32). From ancient times, the Holy Church has retained this tradition of the churching of the mother and new-born child on the fortieth day and of the reading of prayers of purification.

The Apodosis of the Feast of the Meeting in the Temple is usually on the 9th of February. This, however, may vary if the Feast falls within the period of the Triodion. Should this occur, the Typicon should be consulted for specific information concerning the Apodosis of the Feast.

Αν ειστε ενθερμοι, θεωρηστε το δωρο Θεου. Δεν έχουν ολοι αυτο το χαρισμα. Ο Φεβρουαριος ειναι συνηθως ο πιο ψυχρος μηνας του χρονου αλλα επονται οι θερμες θερμοκρασιες της ανοιξης. Ο Φεβρουαριος ειναι ακομη η περιοδος κατα την οποια η Εκκλησια γιορταζει τα Εισοδια του Βρεφους Ιησου στο Ναο, 40 μερες μετα τη γεννηση του. Αυτη ειναι μια απο τις δωδεκα Μεγαλες Γιορτες. Θυμομαστε αυτη τη γιορτη καθε φορα που ερχονται στην εκκλησια μια μητερα με το βρεφος της για τις ευλογιες της σαρακοστης ημερας. Ακομη και αν δεν θυμοσαστε τη δικη σας αυτη ευλογημενη μερα μπορείτε να την αναβιωσετε πνευματικά, στις 2 Φεβρουαρίου, την ημερα που γιορταζουμε την γιορτη των Εισοδίων του Ιησού με το μυστηρίο της Θείας Λείτουργίας. Αν παρεβρεθείτε, οι παροντές θα σας εντάξουν και αυτοί στο εορταστικό κλιμα επείδη η Εκκλησία σας επεστρέψε στους γονείς σας μετά την 40η ημέρα της ευλογίας σας, ωστε να μπορέσετε να ζησετε μια ζωή εν Χρίστω. Καποίοι έχουν αναρωτήθει πως τα πατε με αυτο και επίσης πως τα παω και έγω με αυτο. . . αλλα πολλοί απο εμας δεν θέλουν να απαντήσουν σε αυτο. Ας ελπίσουμε ότι το κρύο του Φεβρουαρίου δεν υπαρχεί στις καρδίες μας.

Hello to you and to February.

If you are warm, consider it a gift from God. Not all have this gift. February is frequently the coldest month of the year but warmer temperatures and spring then follow. February is also when the Church celebrates the Presentation of the Infant Jesus in the Temple, forty days after his birth. This is one of the 12 Great Feasts. We are reminded of this Feast every time an infant and his or her mother are brought to the church for the 40th day blessing. Even if you don't remember your own 40th day blessing you can relive it, spiritually, on February 2nd, when we will celebrate the Feast with a Divine Liturgy. If you appear, those present will also celebrate you because the Church returned you to your parents after your 40th day blessing so you could live a life in Christ and some have asked how you are doing with that and also how I am doing with that . . . but not many of us want to answer that. May the coldness of February not be in our hearts.



The two topics that the students may choose from for this Three Hierarchs/Greek Letters Essay Contest are:



Hi! My name is Andrea (Demetriou)


Kalliaras. My family and I are members of
