

## Κυριακή της Ορθοδοξίας *Sunday of Orthodoxy*



Ἡ πρώτη Κυριακή της Μεγάλης Σαρακοστής ονομάζεται Κυριακή της Ορθοδοξίας, σε ἀναμνηση της ἀναστήλωσης των εἰκόνων. Ἡ ἱερὴ αὐτὴ μερὰ εἶναι ξεχωριστὴ, διότι παρὰ τὸ συγκινητικὸ κλίμα της Μεγάλης Σαρακοστής, γιορτάζει λαμπρὰ ἡ Ορθοδοξία, ἡ ἀληθινὴ Ἐκκλησία τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Ἐνθουσιασθε τὸ κορυφαῖο γεγονός της ἐκκλησιαστικῆς μας ἱστορίας, αὐτὸ της ἀναστήλωσης των ἱερῶν εἰκόνων, τὸ ὁποῖο συνέβη τὸ 843 μ.Χ. στὸ Βυζάντιο, χάρις στὴν ἀποφασιστικὴ συμβολὴ της βασιλισσᾶς καὶ μετεπειτὰ Ἁγίας Θεοδώρας, συζύγου τοῦ αυτοκράτορα Θεοφίλου (840 - 843 μ.Χ.).

Τι εἶναι Ορθοδοξία; Ἡ Ορθοδοξία εἶναι ἡ γνήσια προεκτάσις της Ἐκκλησίας τοῦ Χριστοῦ, ὁ πνευματικὸς χώρος, ὅπου διδασκεται ὀρθὰ τὸ περιεχόμενον της θείας ἀληθείας, ὁ χώρος που βιώνεται τὸ διαρκὲς παρὸν της σωτηρίας καὶ συντελεῖται ἡ μεταμορφωσις τοῦ ἀνθρώπου καὶ τοῦ κόσμου. Ορθοδοξία θὰ πει ἀληθινὴ πίστις καὶ ἀληθινὴ δοξολογία τοῦ Θεοῦ [3]. Αὐτὴ ἡ ἀληθινὴ πίστις μας ὁδηγεῖ στὴν ἀληθινὴ δοξολογία τοῦ Τριαδικοῦ Θεοῦ. Ἄν ἡ πίστις εἶναι ἐσφαλμένη, θὰ εἶναι συγχρονῶς ἐσφαλμένη καὶ ἡ δοξολογία τοῦ Θεοῦ. Ἄν ἡ πίστις δὲν εἶναι ἀληθινὴ, δὲν θὰ εἶναι τὴν δυνατότητα νὰ θεραπεύσει τὸν ἐκπτώτο ἀνθρώπο, ὥστε ἀπὸ τὴν εἰδωλολατρία των παθῶν νὰ ὁδηγηθεῖ στὴν ἀληθινὴ λατρεία τοῦ ἀληθινοῦ Θεοῦ καὶ της κοινωσίας Του.

For more than one hundred years the Church of Christ was troubled by the persecution of the Iconoclasts of evil belief, beginning in the reign of Leo the Isaurian (717-741) and ending in the reign of Theophilus (829-842). After Theophilus's death, his widow the Empress Theodora (celebrated Feb. 11), together with the Patriarch Methodius (June 14), established Orthodoxy anew. This ever-memorable Queen venerated the icon of the Mother of God in the presence of the Patriarch Methodius and the other confessors and righteous men, and openly cried out these holy words: "If anyone does not offer relative worship to the holy icons, not adoring them as though they were gods, but venerating them out of love as images of the archetype, let him be anathema." Then with common prayer and fasting during the whole first week of the Forty-day Fast, she asked God's forgiveness for her husband. After this, on the first Sunday of the Fast, she and her son, Michael the Emperor, made a procession with all the clergy and people and restored the holy icons, and again adorned the Church of Christ with them. This is the holy deed that all we the Orthodox commemorate today, and we call this radiant and venerable day the Sunday of Orthodoxy, that is, the triumph of true doctrine over heresy.

## 25 Μαρτίου – Ο Ευαγγελισμός της Υπεραγίας Θεοτόκου *March 25 - Annunciation of the Theotokos*



Ο Ευαγγελισμός της Θεοτόκου είναι μια από τις θεομητορικές εορτές της Χριστιανοσύνης, σε ανάμνηση της χαρμόσυνης αναγγελίας του Αρχάγγελου Γαβριήλ προς την Παρθένο Μαρία ότι εμπρόκειτο να γεννήσει τον Υιό του Θεού.

Σήμερα η εκκλησία μας γιορτάζει το χαρμόσυνο μήνυμα της Θείας ενσάρκωσης, που με τόσο σαφή τρόπο μας το παρουσιάζει ο Ευαγγελιστής Λουκάς στο Ευαγγέλιο του (κεφ. Α' στίχ. 26-38). Την ημέρα αυτή, ο Θεόσταλτος Αρχάγγελος Γαβριήλ εμφανίσθηκε ξαφνικά μπροστά στη Παρθένο Μαρία και της απηύθυνε τον χαιρετισμό: «Χαίρε κεχαριτωμένη, ο κύριος μετά σου». Η νεαρή γυναίκα ήταν λογικό να πανικοβληθεί, αλλά ο αρχάγγελος την καθησύχασε: «Μη φοβού Μαριάμ, εύρες γαρ χάριν παρά τω Θεώ. Και ιδού συλήψη εν γαστρί και τέξη υιόν και καλέσεις το όνομα αυτού Ιησούν».

Όταν η Παρθένος αναρωτήθηκε πώς ήταν δυνατόν να συλλάβει το παιδί χωρίς άνδρα, ο Αρχάγγελος της απάντησε ότι «το Άγιο Πνεύμα θα έλθει σε σένα και η δύναμη του Υψίστου θα σε επισκιάσει». Τότε η Παρθένος Μαρία του απάντησε ταπεινά: «ΐδου λοιπόν, η δούλη του Κυρίου. Ας γίνει το θέλημα Εκείνου». Επειτα ο Γαβριήλ εξαφανίστηκε από μπροστά της. Ετσι συντελέστηκε το μεγαλύτερο μυστήριο της ανθρωπότητας με τρόπο υπερφυσικό. Η Παρθένος συνέλαβε στην άχραντη κοιλιά της, τον Υιό και Λόγο του Θεού.

### **Απολυτίκιον Εὐαγγελισμός τῆς Θεοτόκου**

Σήμερον τῆς σωτηρίας ἡμῶν τὸ Κεφάλαιον, καὶ τοῦ ἀπ' αἰῶνος Μυστηρίου ἢ φανέρωσις, ὁ Υἱὸς τοῦ Θεοῦ, Υἱὸς τῆς Παρθένου γίνεται, καὶ Γαβριὴλ τὴν χάριν εὐαγγελίζεται. Διὸ καὶ ἡμεῖς σὺν αὐτῷ τῇ Θεοτόκῳ βοήσωμεν· Χαίρε Κεχαριτωμένη, ὁ Κύριος μετὰ σοῦ.

### **Κοντάκιον Εὐαγγελισμός τῆς Θεοτόκου**

Τῇ ὑπερμάχῳ στρατηγῷ τὰ νικητήρια, ὡς λυτρωθεῖσα τῶν δεινῶν εὐχαριστήρια, ἀναγράφω σοὶ ἡ Πόλις σου Θεοτόκε, Ἄλλ' ὡς ἔχουσα τὸ κράτος ἀπροσμάχητον, ἐκ παντοίων μὲ κινδύνων ἐλευθέρωσον, ἵνα κράζω σοὶ, Χαίρε νύμφη ἀνύμφευτε.

Six months after John the Forerunner's conception, the Archangel Gabriel was sent by God to Nazareth, a town of Galilee, unto Mary the Virgin, who had come forth from the Temple a mature maiden (see Nov. 21). According to the tradition handed down by the Fathers, she had been betrothed to Joseph four months. On coming to Joseph's house, the Archangel declared: "Rejoice, thou Full of Grace, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women." After some consideration, and turmoil of soul, and fear because of this greeting, the Virgin, when she had finally obtained full assurance concerning God's unsearchable condescension and the ineffable dispensation that was to take place through her, and believing that all things are possible to the Most High, answered in humility: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word." And at this, the Holy Spirit came upon her, and the power of the Most high overshadowed her all-blameless womb, and the Son and Word of God, Who existed before the ages, was conceived past speech and understanding, and became flesh in her immaculate body (Luke 1:26-38).

Bearing in her womb the Uncontainable One, the blessed Virgin went with haste from Nazareth to the hill country of Judea, where Zacharias had his dwelling; for she desired to find Elizabeth her kinswoman and rejoice together with her, because, as she had learned from the Archangel, Elizabeth had conceived in her old age. Furthermore, she wished to tell her of the great things that the Mighty One had been well-pleased to bring to pass in her, and she greeted Elizabeth and drew nigh to her. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, she felt her six-month-old babe, Saint John the Baptist, prophesied of the dawning of the spiritual Sun. Immediately, the aged Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit and recognized her as the Mother of her Lord, and with a great voice blessed her and the Fruit that she held within herself. The Virgin also, moved by a supernatural rejoicing in the spirit, glorified her God and Savior, saying: "My soul doth magnify the Lord, and my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour," and the rest, as the divine Luke hath recorded (1:39-55).

## *Message from Father Gregory*



Dear Parishioners of Saint Demetrios,

Welcoming March, we should be looking forward to the beginning of Great Lent as a time to come closer to Christ. Our abstaining from certain foods might not be our choice in an ideal world but we do not live in an ideal world. Trying to control what we put in our mouths (food) shows each of us, personally and directly, how difficult it is to control what comes out of our mouths (insults and other words), let alone control our bad thoughts. The objective of Great Lent is not for us to damage ourselves but to realize how many things we do that distance us from Christ. Many who think during Great Lent that they don't need to abstain from eating certain food, abstain from bad thoughts, give alms and pray are the same people who should.






